

Part 4 – FINANCIAL DATA

Every application must be accompanied by a printout of your “Award Information by Year,” printed from the SIS Financial Aid tab showing a summary of your current scholarships and financial aid awards.

In order to be eligible for need-based scholarships, you must provide us with the amount of your Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) completed for 2011-2012 or 2012-2013.

Where can I get my EFC amount?

Go to www.fafsa.ed.gov

- in the “FAFSA Follow-up 3” box click on the “View and Print your Student Aid Report” link
- Choose the school year you are currently in (or the upcoming school year if you have already completed your FAFSA for next year). Then click “Next.”
- Click “Continue.”
- Enter your information including your PIN. Then click “Submit.”
- Click on the number under “Transaction Number”
- On the left side of the next page, click on the “Print Summary” button
- Click on the “SAR (HTML version)” link or the “SAR (PDF version)” link
- Print off the first page of this report (you can cover up/black out any information you don’t want us to see; we just need the EFC amount and your name proving that it is your EFC amount.)
- Attach this page of your Student Aid Report to your scholarship application.

Part 5 – OPTIONAL INFORMATION

There are some scholarships that require additional information. If you meet the basic requirements and would like to be considered for any of these programs, check the box and provide the additional required documents or information:

Chesapeake MIS Scholars

Basic Requirements:

- Major in Management Information Systems
- Grad/Retention GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Involvement in at least one Spears School organization

Additional Required Submissions:

- Resume
- Up to one written page explaining why you selected the MIS field

Williams Diversity and Inclusion Scholarship

Basic Requirements:

- 30-59 Grad/Retention hours at the beginning of Fall, 2012
- Grad/Retention GPA of 3.0 or higher

Special consideration will be given to underrepresented populations, including but not limited to students with diverse cultural experiences.

You must answer the following two questions, each in one page or less:

1. Think about the most influential person that you have been privileged to know. What made this person so influential? What impact did the person have on you and why?
2. Reflect on the statement, “our diversity makes us strong.” Describe a situation where you have witnessed the diversity of an organization or workplace make that group stronger or get better results.

Horning Bootstrap and other critical need support

Basic Requirements:

- A critical need that is not reflected in documents and records

Additional Required Submissions:

- Up to one page explaining your critical need and how a scholarship would alleviate it

Koch Scholars

Basic Requirements:

- *Strong Preference* for Accounting, Finance, or MIS majors.
- Grad/Retention GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Willingness to attend Koch Leadership Day if selected
- Interview with Koch personnel, currently scheduled for late February, if selected in initial screening

Additional Required Submissions:

- Resume

Financial Pathways Program

Basic Requirements:

- At least 60 Grad/Retention hours at the beginning of Fall, 2012
- Apply for the Financial Pathways Program in 333 Business Building
